Nurse Aide (CNA):

A student interested in completing nursing aide training should contact the NMJC Counseling Office at 575-492-2577 for more information. Completion of an NMJC nurse aide course or current certification as a nurse aide is required for admission into the NMJC Nursing (RN) Program.

Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Option:

The student who successfully completes course requirements for Level I, Semesters I and II and Level II, Semester III of the ADN Program is eligible to complete the National Council Licensing Examination-Practical Nursing (NCLEX-PN) for licensure as a practical nurse (LPN).

LPN/LVN to RN Completion Option:

LPNs or LVNs interested in completing the RN program should make an appointment with the Director of Nursing to discuss options.
