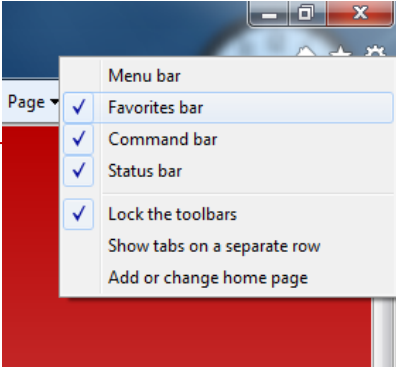


Internet Explorer 9 Settings for Blackboard at NMJC

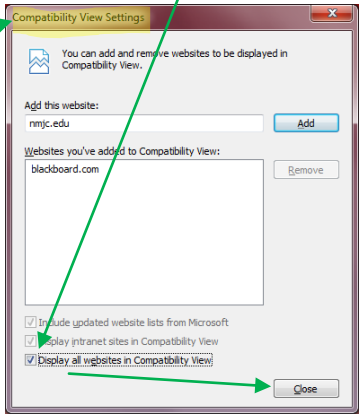
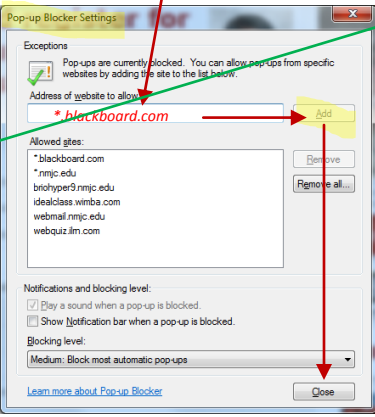
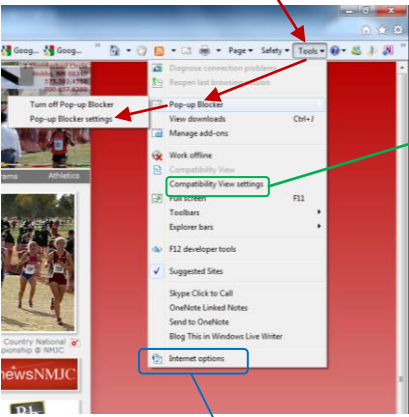
In the upper right of the IE9 window, right-click the 'House' and make sure your checked items match mine. If you have other items after *Status bar*, uncheck and disable them. Click outside the menu to close it.



Select *Tools* on the Command Bar, hover the pointer over **Pop-up Blocker**, and select *Pop-up Blocker settings*.

In the Pop-up Blocker Settings window, type **.blackboard.com* in the *Address of... box* and *Add*. Click *Close*.

Select *Tools* again and select *Compatibility View settings*. In the *...settings* window, put a check in the bottom check box and *Close*.

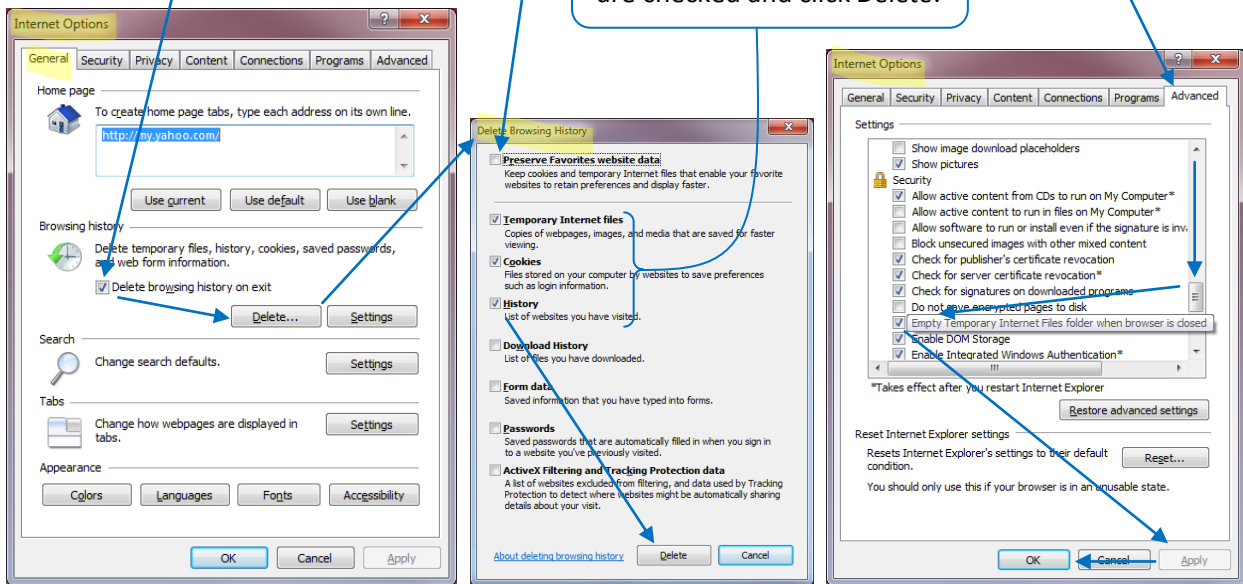
Select *Tools* on the Command Bar, select **Internet options** at the bottom.


On the General tab, put a check mark in the box for *Delete browsing...* and click *Delete*.

Uncheck *Preserve Favorites...*

Make sure the next three are checked and click *Delete*.

On the Advanced tab, scroll down and put a check mark in the box for *Empty Temporary...* and click *Apply* and *OK*.

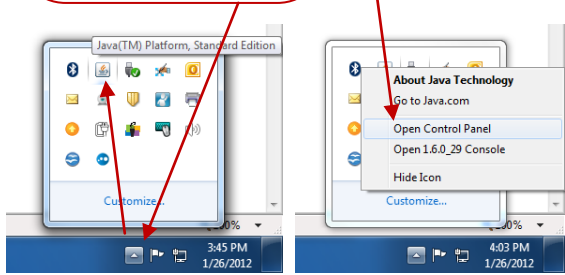


You have finished setting up your IE9 browser. Close IE9 (click  in the upper right corner of the window) and re-open. Now you must set up *Java*. Proceed to page 3.

You must have *Java* on your computer; if you don't, go to www.java.com and download the free java (do not accept any free toolbars). Go to the login page for Blackboard

On your task bar at the bottom right of your screen, click the *Show...* button and right-click the *Java* icon.

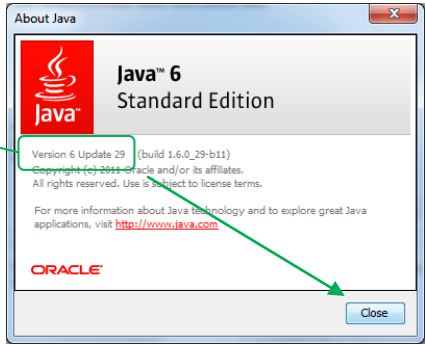
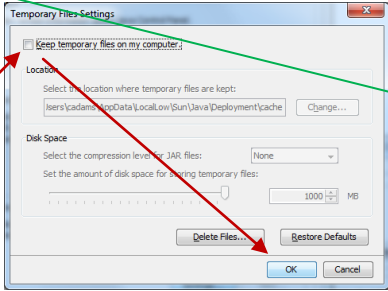
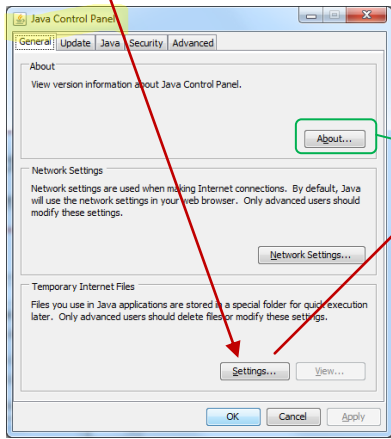
Select *Open Control Panel*.




On the control panel, click *Settings...*

Uncheck *Keep temporary files...* and *OK*.

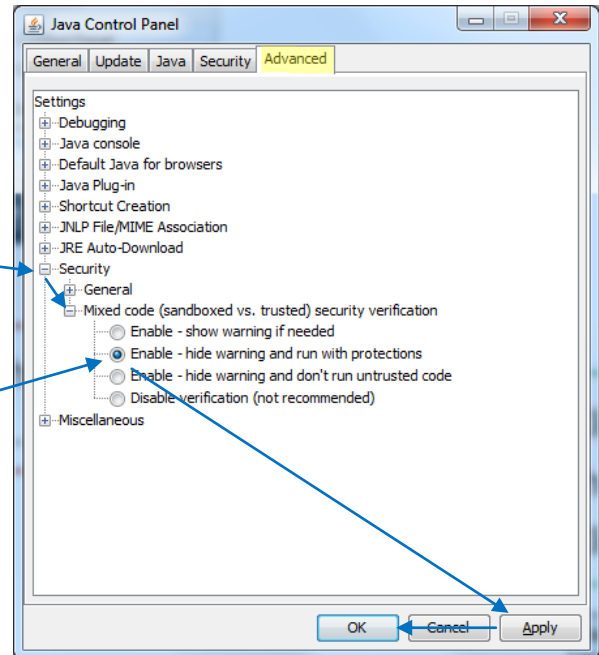
Click the *About* button and note the update number for later. Click *Close*.



Your Java update should be above 19 (keep Java updated). Go to the **Advanced** tab.

Click the  sign next to *Security* and then next to *Mixed code...*

Select the second radio button and then Apply and OK.



Your IE9 browser and Java are now set up to work best with Blackboard.
