Apartments

Single room	\$ 1,700	7 Meals Per Week (112 meals)	\$625
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(Students in Apartments are not required to purchase a meal plan, however, the 7 meals per week is available to apartment residents only.)

Application and Payment

- ~ Residence Halls and Apartments require a \$25 non refundable application fee prior to assignment
- ~ Students who cancel their room before June 1 (Fall), December 1 (Spring) or May 1 (Summer) will receive No Penalty.
- ~ Students who cancel after the above date will be subject to our cancellation policy.

CANCELLATION POLICY

1. The Student may cancel the agreement without penalty on or before **June 1 (fall term), or December 1 (spring term), or May 1 (summer term)**.
2. Students who cancel their agreement after the above date, will be charged according to the schedule below:
 - For cancellation after the applicable deadline but before the beginning of the semester, the Student will be charged a \$250 fee for breach of the agreement.
 - Room cancellations made after the beginning of the semester will receive a refund based on the following schedule.

- 70% during the first week of term
- 60% during the second week of term
- 50% during the third week of term
- 40% during the fourth week of term
- 30% during the fifth week of term
- 0% during & after the sixth week of term

Students with extenuating circumstances that may justify canceling the lease must submit a written request for a waiver to the Student Life Office. Such requests may or may not result in waiver of the fee for breach of the agreement, at the discretion of the College.
