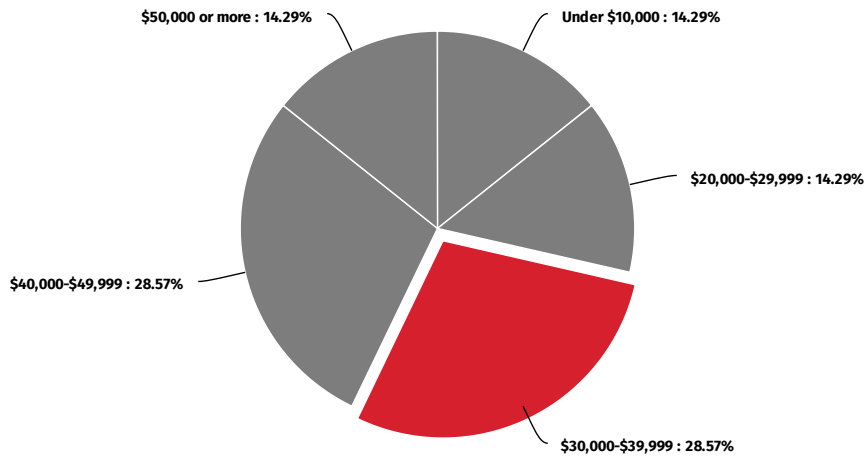

How many hours do you work per week?



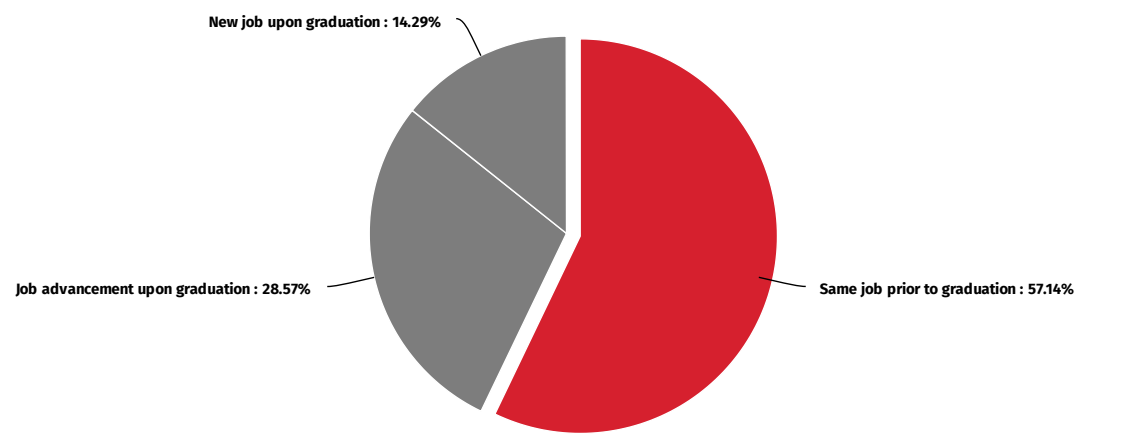

What range best depicts your personal annual income?



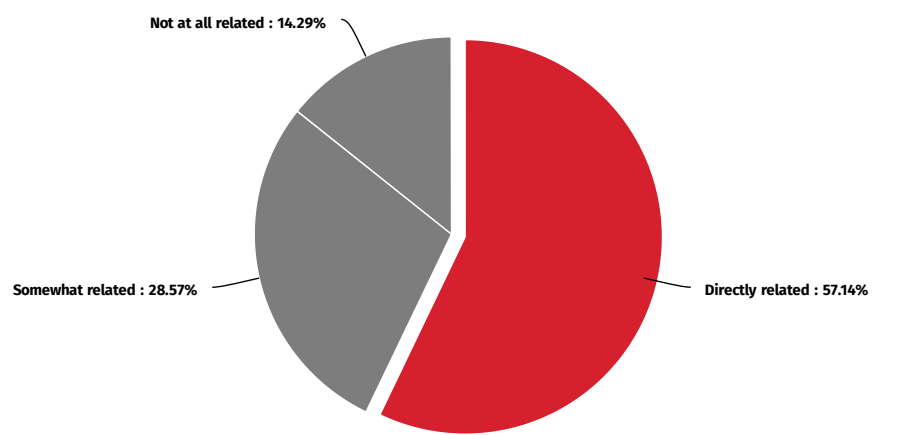

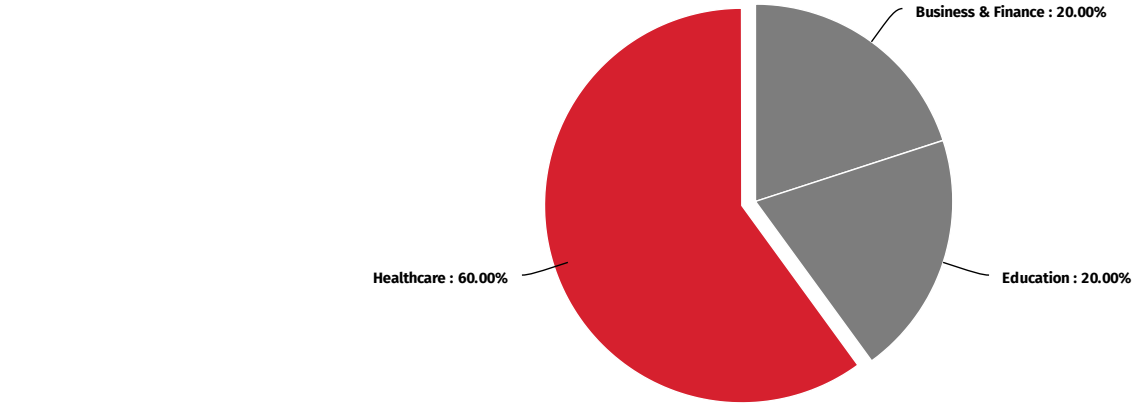

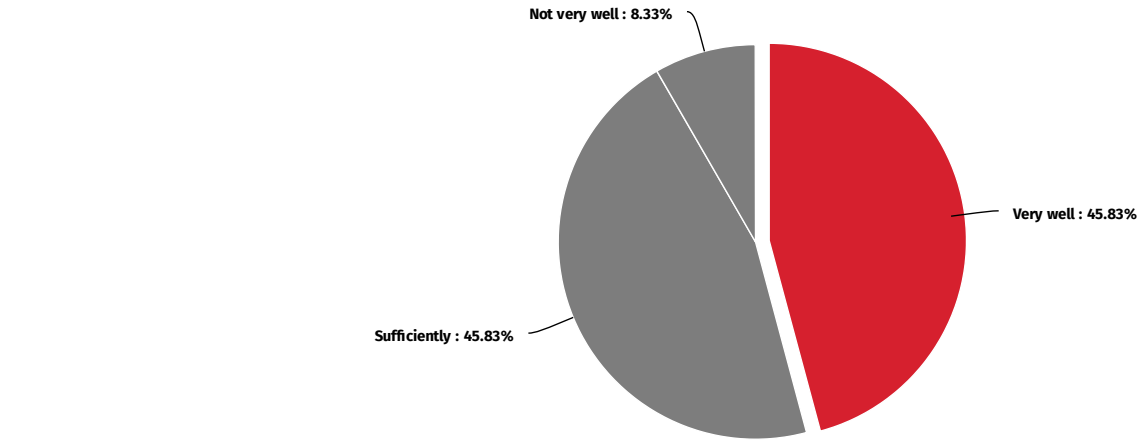
