

## **Student Loan Exit Counseling Requirement**

While attending New Mexico Junior College you received Federal Direct Stafford Student Loan(s). Federal regulations require you to complete **loan exit counseling** upon graduation or if your enrollment at NMJC drops below half-time status. Because you meet one of these criteria, you are required to complete **loan exit counseling**. **Exit counseling** can be completed online at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/exit-counseling/?counselingType=exit">https://studentaid.gov/exit-counseling/?counselingType=exit</a>. You will log into this website using the same FSA ID and password you use to complete your FAFSA. Select **Login to To Start** and follow the process through to completion. NMJC will be notified once the counseling session has been completed. A hold has been placed on your account that will prevent the release of your transcript and will prevent your eligibility for future financial aid until the **exit counseling** has been completed.
