


Accessing the TBirdWeb Portal and Canvas


Step 1- Go to the NMJC website, www.nmjc.edu



Step 2- Under the Quick Links tab, select T-BirdWeb Portal.




Step 3- On the TBirdWeb Portal login page, enter your username and password to log in. If this is your first time logging in, click the *First Time User* link to create your account. You will need to have your A#, birthday, and social security number when setting up your account.




Step 4- The TBirdWeb Portal contains several apps, one of which is your Canvas login. Select the Canvas app to access your Canvas Dashboard.
