SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

PRESIDENT | \$500 Scholarship

Preside over all SGA meetings. Appoint temporary officers to fill vacancies until such time that an election can be held.

VICE-PRESIDENT | \$400 Scholarship

Perform the duties of the President in his/her absence. Vote as a regular member unless presiding, in which case he/she shall vote only in the case of a tie.

TREASURER | \$400 Scholarship

Keep an account of receipts, disbursements, and the balance of the SGA treasury, and at each regular meeting shall give a report thereof.
